Enjoy a fun day of off-road driving in your own vehicle with expert help at hand. Our highly qualified instructors will lead you off-road through spectacular Perthshire countryside, using tracks not available to the public. Bring your family and a picnic with you for a great day out!

Each of these trek days follows a similar format and route. The day starts at 10am at the Land Rover Experience centre at Butterstone Loch, a beautiful setting with stunning views across the loch. From there we will head to the off-road tracks at our driving centre in Dunkeld. The morning will be spent having fun on the vehicle assault course, where you can practise your off-road skills, then the group will depart in convoy to explore private tracks in the Perthshire countryside. We will stop en-route for a picnic lunch then spend the rest of the afternoon in the hills above Dunkeld. The day will finish at around 4pm.

What kind of vehicle? Both of these trek days are for larger 4x4s (eg Discover, Defender, Range Rover and non-Land Rover equivalents). Vehicles will need sufficient ground clearance for the routes we will be using, so give us a call if you are unsure whether your vehicle is suitable. Land Rovers and non-Land Rovers are all welcome! We would advise you to take out off-road insurance for your car. Vehicles must be taxed and fit for purpose, with good tyres, and be suitable for on-road as well as off-road driving. Side steps and body kits are not advised due to the risk of grounding out. Tow balls should be taken off although this is not always practical; if so there will be a risk of grounding out.

Keeping everyone safe: You are welcome to bring family or friends with you in your car, as long as everyone is wearing a seat belt at all times.
